FROM THE EDITOR'S DESK

Bengal Engineering College – Can we keep the name?

The process to convert Bengal Engineering & Science University (BESU), erstwhile Bengal Engineering College, started when State and Central Governments agreed to the terms and conditions of transferring the control of the Institute. It is a matter of time before BESU is renamed Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology – Shibpur. The name BESU/BECDU/BEC will become history. However, the name BE College has a special place in the hearts of those who have been a part of it. We would always like to be called "The Alumni of BE College", a heritage institution with a long and distinguished history. The name is nostalgic to many of us and we would prefer to keep the name alive in some form or other.

Here is my proposal to keep the name BE College as a part of IIEST. This may even be an efficient way to run the new Institution. Like most universities in the USA/Canada, let new IIEST be divided into a number of colleges as shown below. Each college will be headed by a Dean who will report to the Institute Director. The colleges may be called: 1) Bengal Engineering College consisting of Architecture, Mechanical, Civil and Applied Mechanics Departments and any future departments such as Environmental and Production; 2) College of Material Science and Engineering consisting of Metallurgy, Material Science and Mining and future department such as Chemical; 3) College of Computer Science and Engineering consisting of Computer Science, Electrical, Computer Engineering, Tele-communication departments and PBSIT; 4) College of Arts and Sciences; 5) School of Management; and 6) College of Interdisciplinary Studies (if necessary). As old Bengal Engineering College had Civil, Mechanical, Architecture, Applied Mechanics Departments, this will be a logical way to keep this group under BEC. Although Electrical Engineering was a part of old BE College, its closeness to the other groups makes it logical to place in a different group.

We hope that BESU administration will consider this proposal in the future so that we can keep the name BE College alive. Long live our BE College!

IIEST(INI) Status for BESU

It has been learnt that MHRD is preparing the bill for converting BESU to IIEST. We are hopeful that the bill will be presented to the parliament in the winter session. MHRD has also requested BESU administration to prepare a list of its assets at the BESU campus. This is a part of the process to transfer the administration of BESU from the State Government to the Central Government.

Seminar at BESU

Prof. Siben Dasgupta ('67BEEE, '69MEEE) from Boston delivered a seminar at the EE dept on August which was arranged by the EE department through IEEE Calcutta Chapter. The seminar was enjoyed by the faculty and students totaling over 70 and went on for over two hours. He very much appreciated the hospitality shown by the BESU community and sent a letter thanking, specially, Drs. Pratik Dutta (Program sub-committee.), Mainak Sengupta, Gautam Banerjee and Ajit Chattopadyay for their efforts. He was very happy to see his old teachers Dr. Jamini Das and Dr. Chitta R Mahato at the seminar.

GAABESU ACTIVITIES

GAABESU

GAABESU's first AGM will be held on 13th of October at the campus. The Secretary will provide his report at the AGM. The different sub-committees formed to run the activities have developed their plans and programs to be followed in the coming year. EC members around the globe are meeting every month through teleconference to discuss all activities. A second set of names of alumni from abroad for has been sent for FCRA clearance. Discussion has been started to build a Students' Center at the campus with the membership fees from the alumni abroad. As of now, GAABESU has a total of 536 active (Life 513 & Annual 23) and 29 inactive members. Lt. Col. Anjan Ghosh on behalf of Membership sub-committee is trying to enroll more members from the graduating class with the Institute caution money. GAABESU EC has decided that its newsletter will be called "Alumni Link" and is planning to

send hard copy of the newsletter printed through sponsorship, to its members. Thanks to Mr. Amitava Ghoshal, '57CE for being the first sponsor.

GAABESU Scholarship Programme

This has been the most successful alumni program in the short history of GAABESU. This was originally started with 8 scholarships of Rs. 8000 each by a few alumni from Northern California in 1998. The amount was increased to Rs. 10,000 from 2002. Since the formation of GAABESU, scholarships awarded by global alumni groups were unified under the GAABESU umbrella and further expanded with additional monies from other alumni. Fifty-two scholarships of Rs. 10,000 each and 10 book grants of Rs. 1,000 each were awarded for the 2006-07 academic session. This year, observing BESU's 150th anniversary, GAABESU will be awarding 73 full scholarships of Rs. 10,000 each, 3 half scholarships of Rs. 5,000 each, 5 admission grants of Rs. 9,000 each and 15 book grants of Rs. 1,000.00 each, in the total amount of over Rs. 8 lakhs. This scholarship amount is probably the highest of any alumni association in India. The scholarship sub-committee plans to increase the full scholarship to Rs. 12,000 each starting next year. GAABESU thanks all donors for their generosity. Our website provides a list of all donors and recipients of the scholarship.

GAABESU Mentor Programme

A new sub-committee to mentor the present students has been formed. The sub-committee has developed a plan [Click here for details] to administer this program and over 100 students have signed on to avail themselves of this opportunity. The objective of this program is make students aware of available career options and providing guidance to choose the most appropriate one. About 60 alumni have agreed to be mentors. We request more alumni to sign on as mentors.

GAABESU Emergency Programme

This is another successful program which has been operational for a while, thanks to a few alumni who came forward to financially help members of the BESU community facing an emergency situation. With the formation of GAABESU, this



activity is planned on being administered through a sub-committee. The sub-committee has already developed a plan [Click here for details] outlining the process to handle requests as they come to GAABESU and as to how funds should be raised and disbursed. Since the initial inception of the programme a total of about Rs. 45 to 50 lakh has been disbursed. Our website provides a list of all people who have been helped and a list of donors.

A case study of Sujit Ghosh (88CE), a recipient of the alumni emergency fund, has been published in the prestigious medical journal, "Nature" [Click here for detail]. He reiterated his sincere thanks and appreciation to all kinds of help he received in his trying time.

Another recipient from 2002 ETC [Click here for details] joined GAABESU Emergency Sub-Committee to serve as an ambassador of this programme.

We are pleased to inform you that Tania Pramanick, 2006ARCH, a past recipient [Click here for details] has recovered from her illness and has since joined the MTRP programme at BESU.
