FROM THE EDITOR'S DESK

Incidents at BESU

BESU is often in the news for all the wrong reasons. In this calendar year, the campus has been plagued with violence and disturbances repeatedly and it really causes us, the alumni, a real heart-burn. We wonder if it is the same institute that we attended after going through stiff competition! We can look at this from various perspectives. What are the root causes for these types of incidents repeating quite often? What are the cures of these problems? Do we, the alumni, have any role to address these?

Before we go any further, let's see how the general public as well as the alums get information and how much valid they are. Almost always, we get information from news media as neither BESU administration nor other campus organizations care to give us their side of the story. Our experience with newspapers in the past, has taught us that they very often exaggerate things in order to draw attention of the readers. They make mountains out of a mole hill and general public as well as most alums take them as truth. However, GAABESU often receives informal feedback from our members living in and around campus and even from faculty members and students.

With respect to the last disturbance, when police was asked by the administration to enter classrooms, we were very pleased to receive a draft from Electrical Engineering department which detailed the whole incident. We found out how distorted the newspaper report was. Our alumni/alumnae all over the world have been shocked and dismayed at the newspaper report. In order to remove any confusion about the incident, we had no other choice than to distribute the draft to our alums. While, it is not often easy or encouraged to disseminate "facts" outside the campus, we believe it is very important for the alumni/alumnae at large to know the situation inside the campus. For this, we sincerely thank the EE department for sharing the information with us to put things in proper perspective. We also appreciate when recent graduates share their opinions with us.

Now, the question is, what is the role of the alumni in such situations? As GAABESU does not want to get involved with BESU's internal affairs, we have often ignored such news in the past and never published in our website or newsletters. This, of course, did not please our alumni community as they believe it is our role to get involved and advise administration, students and faculty to resolve these issues. Till BESU is upgraded to an INI as IIEST, I think alumni can initiate some activities to address this issue. It is heartening to know some of our senior alumni have initiated discussion with the BESU community to address this. We applaud their efforts.

BESU ACTIVITIES

BESU ties up with Queen's University, Ireland to conduct research on water and environment

The Bengal Engineering and Science University (BESU) has set up a Water Resource Engineering Institute in partnership with the Queen's University, Belfast, to conduct collaborative research on water and environment. Research scholars from both the universities will work together in this centre to develop various technologies for purifying water and making arsenic-free water available at a low cost.

Professor Peter Gregson, Vice-Chancellor of Queen's University, said the research work will help in providing safe drinking water in areas where the arsenic level is high.

The partnership with Queen's University has allowed 20 students from BESU to undertake 10-day summer training at the Queen's University in June this year. To enhance this partnership the BESU has decided to increase the no. of scholarships to 30 for the next academic year. This will help the students to receive hands-on training on research projects there. Each student will receive a grant that will cover tuition fees, accommodation and meals at the university and other activities.

After a day-long interaction between the two universities, BESU vicechancellor, in a statement, said that BESU is trying to follow the example set by the Queen's University in working with the industries.

At the conclusion of the meeting, in a special convocation, BESU conferred DSc (Honoris Causa) to Prof Peter J Gregson, Vice-Chancellor of Queen's University and Lord Diljit Singh Rana, former president of Northern Ireland Chamber of Commerce.

While addressing the special convocation at BESU, state IT Minister Dr. Debesh Das emphasised that most research works are related to the overall development of science and technology in the world, but no one considers the developments in the country.

GAABESU Emergency Fund

GAABESU EC has approved the goals set up by the Emergency Fund Committee to pursue the following initiatives:

This 7-day workshop is a forum for teachers, researchers and designers to present and discuss various aspects of VLSI design, electronic design automation, enabling technologies, and embedded systems. It covers the entire spectrum of activities in the two vital areas of VLSI and embedded systems, which underpin the semiconductor industry. Embedded Systems can now be found in a variety of electronic devices, consumer electronics, home appliances, office automation, business equipments, automobiles, and so on.

Design of such a system is no more an easy task, as it necessitates a good knowledge about the available hardware and software platforms, operating systems, interfacing devices, sensors, networking etc. on one side. On the other side it requires the knowledge of specification techniques, hardware-software co-design approaches, system testing and verification, along with the upcoming issues like low power design, SoC etc. This course aims at introducing the participants to various alternative design techniques commonly in practice in Embedded Systems. On the software side, it will introduce the Real-time Operating Systems with issues responsible in the scheduling policies. The hardware-software codesign techniques will be discussed.
