#### SECRETARY'S REPORT

It is my great pleasure in reporting the activities of Global Alumni Association of Bengal Engineering and Science University (GAABESU) before you, the members of the Association, at this Annual General Meeting (AGM). This is the first AGM of the elected Executive Committee (EC).

### **Formation of the Association**

Although there were Alumni Associations for many years in different cities of India, their activities were primarily restricted to re-union and get-together to foster fellowship and camaraderie. Similarly with the emigration of Alumni to the western countries, they started to Alumni Associations for reunion and to reminisce about the college days. However, this started to change when they witnessed how their beloved Institute suffers due to lack of fund-flow for development of State-of-the-art laboratories and other infrastructures. Some of the Alumni also felt to move for achieving the status of an Institute of National Importance in order to maintain its excellence. During this time, 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Institute was also coming up. At this time few Alumni from India and abroad got together and thought of forming a Global Alumni Association so that those two activities and other activities initiated by the Alumni from abroad to upgrade the infrastructure or to help the stakeholders of the Institute, can be co-ordinated. With those goals and objectives in mind GAABESU has been formed and Registered as per West Bengal Societies Act XXVI of 1961 Vide Registration no S/IL/29880 of 2005-2006 dated 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2005.

### **Activities**

- 1. **Office** In order to carry out GAABESU activities professionally, an office has been set up in the Alumni House in BESU campus with help of BESU authority. Office is staffed by two full time Office Assistants and equipped with computer, phone, high-speed Internet access and fax.
- 2. **EC Meeting** EC Members meets regularly and Minutes of Meetings all are distributed to all members electronically and also it is posted in GAABESU web site.
- 3. **Bank Operation** A Bank account with United Bank of India (UBI), BESU Campus, Shibpur. has been opened as required by GAABESU rules and regulations. All membership subscriptions in Rupee are deposited in this account and operated per our rules.
- 4. **Overseas Membership Subscription/Contribution** As per rules of Government of India, remittance to Associations from overseas are regulated by Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act 1976 (FCRA). GAABESU has been approved (vide letter no.II/21022/94(0030-02)/2006-FCRA III dated 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2007 from Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, New Delhi) to receive subscription in foreign currency for the first batch of alumni. Rs.12,20,794.00 equivalent to US \$ 27,660.00 has been deposited in a designated account with the United Bank of India, BESU Campus. Per FCRA rules, this fund can only be used in the development activity and has been kept in Fixed Deposit with UBI till the project is started. Another application has been sent for permission to get similar fund from abroad for a second batch of Alumni.
- 5. **Fund in fixed Deposit** Membership Funds shown below have been kept in fixed deposit with UBI till date.
  - a) Local Fund Rs.6,50,000.00
  - **b**) Foreign Fund in FCRA A/c Rs.12,20,000.00
- **6. Conversion of BESU** This effort was started in 2003 by a group of Alumni. With the formation of GAABESU, this activity got a big boost and all Alumni have since been actively supporting this cause at all levels. It is heartening to note that this matter is progressing nicely.
- 7. Scholarship Awarding scholarships to the needy but meritorious students of the Institute is probably our most successful activity. From 8 scholarships in 1998 (started by Swapan Saha, Subrata Ghosh and Sripati Bhattacharya in Northern California), GAABESU awarded over 50 scholarships and admission grants in 2006-2007 totaling about INR 4.5 lakhs to the needy students.

- **8. Benevolent Activity** GAABESU has been able to help few of our Alumni/Alumnae by providing emergency aid that was facing financial difficulties. We thankfully acknowledge the contributions of all Alumni to this fund. Total contribution is estimated to be INR 50 lakhs since 1998-99 (long before the formation of GAABESU). The names of the recipients are listed in our website. A plan as to the scope of emergency aid, how to raise and disburse fund has been developed and is being circulated for comments. Once the comments are addressed, EC will approve it and the plan will be posted to our website.
- 9. Development of Brochure As stated earlier there was no central body in the past to plan and execute development activities supported by Alumni for our Alma Mater. In spite of that from time to time a few Alumni took it upon themselves to collect funds for upgrading laboratories/infrastructure. To name a few are LAN Project, VLSI Laboratory, Seminar Room, etc. A brochure has been prepared during this reporting period showing these development activities along with fund spent and details of donors. Total fund collected and spent for all these activities is about 2 Crores. An electronic copy of the brochure is posted in our website. We thankfully acknowledge efforts of few GAABESU volunteers (Debargha Sengupta, Swapan Saha, Manoj Bhattacharya and Tarun Basu) who prepared this Brochure since Chancellor of our Alma Mater and Hon'ble Governor of West-Bengal Shri Gopal Krishna Gandhi wanted to know contribution of Alumni for Development of BESU.
- 10. Program Various Programs of Seminars are arranged by the Alumni or renowned professors. Few alumni (primarily Ashish Basu) donated fund to meet the expenses for these seminars. During this period, several Alumni have delivered seminars and these seminars have been well appreciated and attended by faculties and students. We appreciate effort of many alumni and BESU Faculty who had taken the lead role in arranging these seminars on behalf of GAABESU. A list of seminar speakers is shown in our web site. GAABESU chapters located at various places have been lending support to visiting Alumni and/or Faculty whenever they need same during out station or overseas visit.
- **11. Publicity** Communication amongst all stakeholders are key to success for any organization. GAABESU had taken following initiative: -
  - Web site In keeping with time GAABESU has taken control of the Web site ... <a href="http://www.becollege.org">http://www.becollege.org</a> (created by Subrata Ghosh and Swapan Saha, later assisted by Pranesh Biswas, Chitta Hati and Apurba Tribedi about 10 years back). This web site is continuously updated with all news and information. I must record with sincerity that today whatever growth GAABESU achieved is mainly due to awareness among Alumni we have been able create through this web site.
  - Mass Mailing We have created a database of nearly 5000 of our Alumni spread all over the World. Whenever we have any important announcement to make same is broad caste through mass mailing by e-mail to this database. I am sure most of the alumni accessing their e-mail are getting updated information by this most cost effective solution. I would request all of you to provide contact information of fellow alumni/alumnae who do not get any mails.
  - Yahoo Group We have created various groups mailing through Yahoo Group.
     With this we are informing all specific groups any particular relevant information as required.

# Activities from April 1, 2007 to Date

The newly elected EC took responsibility to run GAABESU at the end of last financial year on 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2007. It will be more than six months since then that we are meeting for our first AGM:-

• <u>Upgradation</u> – We are pleased to note that the initiative taken by all including GAABESU for upgradation of our alma mater as an Institute of National Importance (INI) is progressing quite satisfactorily. The Central and West-Bengal Government have agreed to the terms and conditions to hand over our Institute to the CG. It is expected that the CG will place a bill in the winter session of the parliament in this regard. Once the bill is passed, our Institute will be known as Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology, Shibpur (INI). It is now matter of time

- that efforts by many Alumni along with BESU authority and other well-wishers will be fruitful and our dream to revive its glory will be a reality.
- <u>Major Initiative by EC</u> Since taking over, newly elected EC has taken a few major initiatives to achieve GAABESU objectives. A brief description of the activities are given below:
  - a) <u>Broader representation in the EC In order to give proper representation of geographical locations EC has nominated "Permanent Invitees" (PIs) to the EC. PIs will not only be active members but also will allow GAABESU to reach all locations around the globe.</u>
  - <u>b) Tele-Conference of EC Meeting</u> As a number of EC members and PIs are located in various parts of the world, we have started all our EC Meeting via teleconferencing. Tele-conference process is made known to all EC Members and with meeting notice announced well in advance, all EC members are able to join and participate actively in the EC meetings.
  - c) GAABESU Plans and Program This has been adopted by the EC during 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 26th May, 2007. In order fulfill our objectives following Sub-Committees has been formed:-:
    - Membership Achieve systematic growth in all locations.
    - Development –Steer major and minor Development Projects for BESU.
    - Corpus Fund Raise Fund required for all Development Projects.
    - Scholarship Fund Raise and administer Scholarship Program.
    - Benevolent Fund Raise and administer all benevolent activity.
    - Program Organize all Programs in BESU as required and also render support to other chapters/locations.
    - Publicity Improve awareness and understanding amongst all stakeholders.
    - Finance and Administration Smooth functioning both these area.
    - Mentorship Help/Guide BESU students as required and possible (This has been added later on)
  - d. Functioning of Sub-Committees All these Sub-committees has been headed by Chairman, Co-Chairman, Convener, Members etc. These Sub-Committees are broad based with inclusion of members from all locations as far as possible as required. Some of these Sub-Committees are made with members who have been carrying same function earlier like Scholarship, Benevolent Fund etc. But other Sub-Committees are new and have just started functioning.
    - e. Scholarship This Sub- Committee awarded 5 admission grants of total INR 45,000.00 to financially assist needy students, who qualified for admission to BESU through WBJEE ranking, but were not in a position to secure admission due to financial constraints. This Sub-Committee has finalized the list for the year 2007-08 and expect to award scholarships to all 67 selected students. To achieve this goal, Mr. Rajdeep Dutta and Dr. Swapan Saha had started another campaign few days back for donations from alumni. We are happy to report that they have been successful in getting pledges for 10 more scholarships. Although, few more pledges are required to achieve this goal, they are hopeful to award scholarships to all those candidates.
    - <u>f. Publicity</u> Mr. Samir Gupta, Chairman of this Sub-Committee arranged a Press Conference at Kolkata Press Club on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2007 "Global Alumni unite for immediate upgradation of Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur to Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology (IIEST), an Institute of National Importance (INI)". This press conference was a huge success in terms of number of media representatives covering this event and the number of news articles published in the print and online media.

GAABESU has been publicizing Institute's cause be it for the conversion to INI or for the help to the needy students through scholarship or upgrading facilities at BESU for a long time. A few of our alumni through their personal contacts with the print media got a number of favorable news articles published in Calcutta & India Abroad (weekly published in New York). On behalf of the Publicity Sub-committee, Tarun Basu, Swapan Saha and Debargha Sengupta have taken upon themselves to publish the newsletter and last

one was published on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2007. It has been circulated by e-mail and posted in our web site. Mr. Amitava Ghoshal has kindly agreed to sponsor the printing of the hard copy of the last newsletter for mailing it to the members. It will be sent to those Alumni who do not have e-mail.

g. Membership – This Sub-Committee has taken active steps for Membership growth. Dr. Swapan Saha and Prof. Anjan Kumar Ghosh have been trying to enroll new graduates for almost a year through their connection. We are happy to note that his efforts are paying off and more than 80 new alumni/alumnae have accepted to become members. We are hoping that we will be able to enroll 200 such members. Now our Membership strength as on 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2007 is as follows:-

h) <u>Finance and Administration</u>- We found many anomalies and discrepancy in our "Memorandum of Association and Regulations" when we started operation after registration. This Committee has made amendment as required for proper functioning of GAABESU and it is put up for approval in AGM.

We have submitted to Govt, of India FCRA year-end Report as per rule.

<u>Recognition</u> – Many of our alumni around the globe have achieved many personal Milestones. We are all proud of them. We also recognize the leaderships of many of our alumni who have played vital roles in achieving many commendable milestones for their organizations during last year. GAABESU recognizes and salutes them. We convey our best wishes to those alumni and their team for such achievement and expect them to continue such work. These are not only their personal accomplishments but also recognition of our Alma Mater that has nurtured them. I have stated a few names in the report. However some names might have been missed to report inadvertently and do apologise in advance for any such mistakes, if any.

Appreciation- I on behalf of EC fully appreciate selfless works put up by Ad-hoc EC and many other Alumni all over the World without which GAABESU could never be at this stage. I shall also fail in my duty if I do not mention help and co-operation extended by all our members located throughout the world without whose help and active participation are essential for GAABESU to function. I appreciate all help extended by BESU authorities, Faculty and others in administration without whose help it would not have been possible to move GAABESU forward. I appreciate the enthusiasm and contributions of our two office assistant who have worked many hours to keep GAABESU functioned. At the end I thank all Alumni/ Alumnae irrespective of their affiliations with GAABESU for their help and guidance. I am grateful to all EC and PI members for sharing my load and help making GAABES the best Alumni Association in India.
