With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of our muchloved fellow alumnus, Kaushik Chatterjee, who departed this world on January 24, 2024, in Gurugram, Haryana. He was 55 years old.

A proud graduate of the 1991 Batch of BE College, Shibpur, Kaushik's journey as a civil engineer was emblematic of the values instilled in him during his time at our alma mater. In his 31 years of service at the Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd. (NPCIL), he led the development of several key nuclear power projects in the country, such as those in Kaiga (Karnataka), Kakrapara (Gujarat), where he was the reactor

building expert, and most recently in Gorakhpur, Haryana, where he was posted as Chief Engineer. His dedication, expertise, and unwavering commitment to excellence brought honor to our institution. Beyond his professional achievements, Kaushik was a cherished member of our alumni community. His legacy of hard work, humility, and kindness will be cherished by all who had the privilege of knowing him.

Kaushik is survived by his wife, Mrs. Arpita Chatterjee, and his daughters, Debanjali Chatterjee and Diksha Chatterjee. His family was his anchor, and his love for them knew no bounds. Our thoughts and prayers are with them during this difficult time.
